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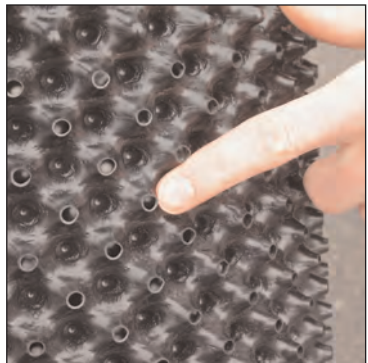




SuperTrees are grown in special containers that use air to keep the roots from circling. These superior roots are what make SuperTrees grow faster than trees grown in conventional containers.

HOW IT WORKS:

The shape of the container guides growing roots toward a hole. Since a root doesn't grow in air, it will stop growing once it reaches the hole. This is called "air-pruning". The air-pruning process develops healthy, fibrous, white-tipped roots. These healthy roots establish quickly and are most efficient at absorbing nutrients.



The root systems shown here have had the soil washed out. SuperTree roots are thick, fibrous and ready for transplant.

PROBLEMS CAUSED BY COMMON POTS:

Traditional plastic nursery containers cause the roots of trees to grow in a circling pattern inside the pot. After transplant, these circling roots will grow larger and create problems for the tree in the future.

Primary market research indicates that 73% of nursery professionals think that circling roots are a problem.



DARE TO COMPARE!

Poor quality root systems of conventionally grown trees can cause major problems over the life of the tree. Many newly planted trees only live 5-10 years before health problems and often death occur. Planting a SuperTree improves the chance of your investment living a long and healthy life.
